SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. EVENT TITLE, DATE AND VENUE

The Event shall be known as “2019 Rightway Industrial Saloon Car Nationals and NT Commodore Cup Enduro” herein referred to as “The Event” and will be held on 6 -8 September 2019 at Hidden Valley Raceway, Darwin. CAMS Permit No 519/0809/03

2. ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- (a) The Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the Nationals Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the 2019 Saloon Car Nationals Sporting Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, Bulletins and Instructions to Competitors that may be issued.
- (b) The Event shall be a Multi-Club Race Meeting.
- (c) This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

5. ENTRIES

Maximum number of entries and selection will be in accordance with the relevant Category Sporting Regulations.

Entry Fees are as arranged with Category Management.

Entry Lodgement

Opening Date: On publication of these Regulations

Closing Date: 31 August 2019

Submit entries **complete with all details, signatures and entry fee** via the NAMSC website – www.namsc.org.au.

With the submission of their entry, the Competitor(s) give their agreement, also on behalf of their Driver, Pit Crew and Sponsors, that the Organiser may record all activities in connection with the Event, and have them transmitted by radio, television or other media. No claims against the Organiser or the transmission company may be raised.

Late Entries

Late Entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Category Manager and/or Event Organiser, up to 5 days before the event.

All entries accepted under this circumstance, may incur a Rear of Field (ROF) starting position for Race 1 and 2, in the category entered for the nominated Driver of the vehicle at the discretion of the Category Management.

Refusal of Entries

Refusal of entries shall be in accordance with NCR 83.

6. EVENTS

The Event includes races counting toward the 2019 Saloon Cars Nationals and a standalone Commodore Cup enduro event. Whilst the Organiser do not anticipate any problems, it may be necessary to change the Program to ensure that the timetable runs to schedule. In this case, affected categories will be notified by the Organisers as soon as possible.

Commodore Cup – For Drivers and automobiles complying with Group 3D: Commodore Cup (VB-VH) Technical Regulations. This Category will run under Club Level Conditions.

Saloon Cars - For Drivers and automobiles complying with Group 3K Saloon Cars as published in the CAMS Manual. This Category will run under Multi Club Level Conditions.

7. LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Each Driver must hold a CAMS Competition Licence, being a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit unless otherwise noted in the Sporting Regulations.

Commodore Cup competitors must be a current member of the North Australian Motor Sport Club.

The Organiser confirms that the circuit to be used for this Event will hold the necessary CAMS National Track Licence for each of the events nominated in these Supplementary Regulations.

8. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilize an automatic timing system, which requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter which is the competitor's responsibility. Data 1 Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, 6/29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing, VIC 3029. Phone 03 9562 2199

9. CREDENTIAL ALLOCATION

As agreed with the relevant Category Management Organisation.

10. ADVERTISING ON VEHICLES

Advertising on vehicles shall be in accordance with the relevant Category Sporting Regulations and NCR 155.

11. SCRUTINY

Documents to be presented include:

- Current CAMS Competition Licence for the Competitor and Driver/s
- CAMS Affiliated Club Membership Card for Driver
- CAMS Passbook for Driver
- CAMS Vehicle Logbook

Scrutiny/Document Inspection location and times shall be advised in Further Regulations. Targeted Scrutiny procedures shall apply at this Event.

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions as per Schedule B.

12. ALCOHOL DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS “competition” or “Officials” licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or any other banned substance) and subject to the penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS illicit drugs in sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of Alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under control of the officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, and holder of a CAMS “Competition” or “Officials” licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of Alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

13. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au

Every Competitor and Driver must sign the disclaimers and Entrant Statement on the Entry Form before taking part in any competition event. This shall include a statement attesting that the entered automobile conforms to its applicable eligibility criteria and is in a fit state for the proposed competition.

Officials must sign on every day of the event.

14. PROTESTS

Competitors are reminded of their Right of Protest as prescribed in NCR Part XII.

15. POSTPONEMENT ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

Events may be postponed, abandoned or cancelled in accordance with NCR 59 or the relevant Category Sporting Regulations.

16. PARADES DEMONSTRATIONS AND PASSENGER RIDES

These may be held and will be conducted under NCR 20A and 20B for such Parades and Demonstrations.

This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

17. MEDICAL

Medical requirements will be in accordance with Article 3.1.4.3 Alternative Medical Service/Requirements (CAMSR) of the CAMS Medical Service Requirements at Motor Sport Events.
